During the Compensation Subcommittee meeting on June 22, 2016, an executive session will be called per RCW 42.30.110(1)(f) - To receive and evaluate complaints or charges brought against a public officer or employee or for any such purpose as may be authorized by law.

Additionally, the Compensation Subcommittee may reconvene Thursday, June 23, 2016 no earlier than 6:30 a.m.

While the Compensation Subcommittee meeting is intended to be held on Tuesday and Wednesday only, the meeting is being noticed for Thursday also to ensure all requirements are met if the subcommittee needs to meet again during the course of the following day in preparation for Executive Board-related actions.
