Chief Executive Officer Report

Mr. Mark Reddemann, Chief Executive Officer, provided the CEO Report. Key highlights included: welcoming new Board of Directors member representative Craig Fulton from the city of Port Angeles; recent member visits; this week's Public Power Forum; the Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems recent board meeting that was held at Columbia Generating Station; Energy Northwest's option to operate the UAMPS small modular reactor; the nuclear task force's upcoming meeting; new survey data in support of nuclear energy; Washington nuclear

science week; Public Power Week including The Energy Experience and member social media postings; recent CEO recognition lunches; Goizueta Directors Institute; the World Association of Nuclear Operators' biennial meeting; and high-level asset performance review.

Mr. Reddemann wrapped up by addressing several questions from the governing boards.

Report from the Chief Nuclear Officer

Mr. Grover Hettel, acting Vice President of Nuclear Generation and Chief Nuclear Officer, presented the Chief Nuclear Officer Report. Key points included: plant status; reactor feedwater valve; control rod blade stellite; Nuclear Regulatory Commission update; industry update; upcoming events and Columbia Generating Station performance indicators.

Mr. Hettel also shared a video on Columbia's FLEX Strategy.

Contracts Review Update
