I understand that Energy Northwest has submitted a license renewal application for the Columbia Generating Station to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for a twenty year extension of the operating license. I am pleased to support your efforts to pursue license renewal.

As Washington state and the nation look to produce cleaner, cheaper energy, it is my strong belief that nuclear power is an essential part of an all-of-the-above energy strategy. The Columbia Generating Station currently provides six percent of Washington's power supply both safely and efficiently.
