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BPA Report

Ms. Cherie Sonoda from BPA provided a brief update of current water conditions and other BPA-related information.

Investigation Update

Mr. Skip Orser provided an update of the Executive Board independent investigation.

Chief Executive Officer Report

Mr. Mark Reddemann, Chief Executive Officer, provided the CEO Report. Key highlights included: Democratic resolution; nuclear science week; recent CEO recognition lunches; bargaining units; time-loss injury; charitable giving; and the upcoming Public Power Forum. Mr. Reddemann wrapped up by addressing several questions from the governing boards.

Chief Nuclear Officer Report

Mr. Brad Sawatzke, Chief Operating Officer and Chief Nuclear Officer, presented the CNO Report. Key points included: plant status; significant plant work; regulatory update; evaluation preparation; Columbia Generating Station performance indicators; and proposed performance review.

The meeting recessed for a break at 9:08 a.m.; and reconvened at 9:24 a.m.

Mr. Sawatzke continued with the discussion of the proposed performance review; and upcoming events.

Net Billing Agreement

Mr. Bob Dutton, General Counsel and Chief Ethics Officer, presented the net billing agreement. Key highlights included: introduction and background of the Net Billing Agreement; Prudent Utility Practice Standard; Participants Review Board; and Direct Pay Agreement. Discussion ensued.

Contracts Review Update

Mr. Greg Sponholtz, Supply Chain Services manager, presented the contracts review update. Key contracts discussed included: Refueling and maintenance outage 23 and 24 reactor recirculation pumps "A" and "B" replacement; bulk chemical – orthophosphate; and R23 flow accelerated corrosion examinations.

Bid Limits

Mr. Sponholtz presented a bring back to the board regarding bid limits. Key highlights included: July 2008 legislation changing purchase and contract limit without competition from \$10,000 to \$25,000 for public utilities (not for joint operating agencies); in January 2015 Energy Northwest engaged to make a legislation change; in June 2015 legislation was approved; and in September 2016 EN revised associated procurement procedures utilizing the \$25,000 bid threshold.

Other Business

Discussion ensued on the Executive Board's notification protocol policy and the interest of the BOD and PRB adopting the protocol into each of their board rules.
