Listed below are reminders, tips, and additional information for the Resource Coordination Meeting, March 27 and March 28, 2019.

1. RSVP

2. Parking near the WPUA building, 212 Union Avenue SE

- Parking near the building may be limited. Plan ahead to allow for sufficient time to park and walk to the WPUA building. WPUA does not have its own parking lot.
- There is metered parking on the street for 60 cents per hour (you can pay by phone as well, if you follow the instructions on the meter).
