Mark Reddemann assumed duties as CEO of Energy Northwest on Aug. 9, 2010.

Prior to his current position, he was vice president of Operations Support with Xcel Energy, during which he also served on the Energy Northwest Corporate Nuclear Safety Review Board.

From 2005 to 2006 Mr. Reddemann was vice president of Nuclear Assessment with Nuclear Management Company. Before that position, he was vice president of Plant Technical Support at the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations, following positions as vice president of Engineering at NMC, and site vice president at NMC's Kewaunee and Point Beach Nuclear Power Plants. Before joining NMC he worked at several nuclear plants across the country, including Hope Creek, Salem, Columbia and Prairie Island.

Mr. Reddemann holds a bachelor's degree in applied mathematics, engineering and physics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and is a graduate of the Minnesota Management Institute at the University of Minnesota Curtis L. Carlson School of Management.

Mr. Reddemann also serves on the New Brunswick Power Board of Directors, Tri-City Development Council executive board, Association of Washington Business board of directors, Nuclear Energy Institute board of directors, and chairs the Ontario Power Generation Nuclear Safety Review Board and the Tri-Cities March for Babies.
